The first link below is to a video montage of graduates from our Create self-employment programme. This programme is supported through EU Regional Development funding and Radian's activities are provided in partnership with Optivo, Clarion, the University of East Anglia and French partners such as Habitat Pas De Calais. In overview 210 participants from our communities have so far completed the programme with some great success stories. We have focussed our activities within our Southampton, Portsmouth & Gosport and rural East Hants Community Investment Zone areas (of 6 zones across our geography).

Each year we track our Community Impact through use of HACT's Social Return on Investment model and importantly, produce case studies outlining the difference we make through our portfolio of programmes, which include the Good Grub Club holiday hunger programmes in Millbrook and the 2019 Queens Award winning Roundabout Café volunteer programme in Mansbridge (Southampton) which is also a hub for our PALS research programme with Southampton University and the National Institute for Health Research; combatting social isolation through use of new technology using the GENIE application .
